- Read with your children EVERYDAY and have conversations about the stories.
- Engage in conversation with your child every day by asking open-ended questions.
- Limit use of technology.
- Maintain communication with your child's teacher.



Intervention Strategies

Parents:

- Develop a partnership/relationship with the teacher to increase student learning.
- Send your child to school prepared to learn.
- Make sure your child studies and completes homework assignments.
- Support your teachers and hold your child accountable for their actions.
- Attendance: Send your child to school every day (stay home when sick).
- Monitor your child's progress (Parent Portal, Grades, homework assignments, attendance, etc.).
- Support your child by attending Back to School Nights, Parent Teacher Conferences, and school events.
