

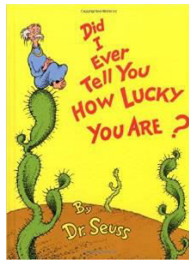
November was a very short and quick month, but we still had a lot of activities going on both inside and outside of the classrooms.

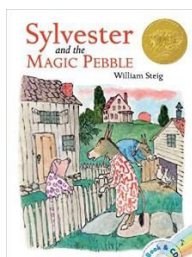

Dr. Seuss – Did I Ever Tell You How Lucky You Are?



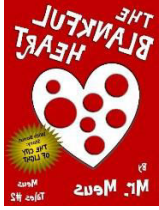
The moral of this story is to focus on what you have and not to dwell on the bad.
